

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR of ANALYTICAL CHEMISTRY

The **Department of Chemistry** at the **University of Florida** invites applications for a nine-month, tenure-track **ASSISTANT PROFESSOR** position in **ANALTICAL CHEMISTRY** to begin in August 2018 as part of UF's Preeminence Initiative in Metabolomics. Research interests in analytical techniques for the separation and characterization of small molecules of biological and biomedical significance are of particular interest. UF and the Department of Chemistry are committed to increasing faculty diversity, and candidates from underrepresented groups are particularly encouraged to apply. Successful applicants will be well supported with start-up resources and lab space, and will be associated with the NIH-funded Southeast Center for Integrated Metabolomics (www.secim.ufl.edu). Candidates must have earned a PhD in chemistry or relevant discipline. They must be prepared to establish their own independent, extramurally funded research program and maintain a strong commitment to scholarship and teaching.

The deadline for applications is OCTOBER 25, 2017.
